Present: Commissioners Patricia Connors, Allyn Hammel, Willard Bird, Michael Koss; Treasurer Debra Kuhn; Chief Adam Leggett and Attorney Ray DiRaddo via phone.

Excused: Commissioner Brian Frew.

Treasurer Kuhn discussed possible options for financing the acquisition of the Medina aerial ladder truck and the timeline for putting the referendum up for a vote. We need to do a timeline for publicizing it to the public justifying the transfer/sale of our truck and purchasing the Medina truck.

A public hearing/public information meeting should be held outlining the justification for purchasing the Medina truck now rather than waiting to replace the Quint on our truck replacement schedule as the cost will be much higher (prices historically have increased 3% to 5% annually, and will require the Fire District to bond the truck (which will have to go to a mandatory referendum). It was decided to put this proposal to vote at the December annual election.

A permissive referendum (30-day notice) will be needed to expend money out of the capital reserves. A mandatory referendum (vote) will be needed to sell our truck (as the value is over \$100,000).

The letter of intent drafted by Attorney DiRaddo was reviewed and modifications were suggested. Attorney DiRaddo will revise the letter of intent and return for review.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:44 AM.
