**RESOLUTION 2026-36**

**Purchase of 4 - 6 inch Hydra-Ram II, Forcible Entry Tools**

The following resolution was adopted by the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Brockport Fire District on August 17, 2026:

Resolution to expend from the “Brockport Fire District Miscellaneous Equipment and Furnishings Capital Reserve Fund” for the purchase of 4 Hydro Rams- 6 inch .

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to §6-g of the General Municipal Law, the Brockport Fire District, Towns of Sweden and Clarkson, County of Monroe, State of New York, did establish the “Brockport Miscellaneous Equipment and Furnishings Capital Reserve Fund”, a capital reserve fund to finance the cost of acquisition or replacement of miscellaneous equipment and furnishings utilized in the operation of the Brockport Fire District, including, but not limited to, furnishings and furniture for the fire stations, miscellaneous incidental equipment required to maintain the fire district’s facilities and other non-firefighting equipment and furnishings that are included in the definition of capital as set forth in General Municipal Law §6-g but not within the purposes of the other Brockport Fire District §6-g Capital Reserve Funds.

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to purchase the Hydra-Ram II, Forcible Entry tools, 6-inch max thrust opening. These tools will be an extremely useful tool for our firefighters, when it comes to breaking open stubborn, inward-opening metal or wooden doors in commercial buildings, apartments, and residential doors. This can be used to spread door frames, popping deadbolts and security latches where traditional manual irons are too slow or difficult. Having this valuable piece of equipment available for our volunteers will allow single operators or small teams to breach entry points too quickly to ensure the safety of our volunteers and allow our volunteers to work smarter and not harder with fewer personnel.

**WHEREAS**, the purchase of the Hydra-Ram II, Forcible Entry tools, is to be financed from monies in the above-referenced “Brockport Fire District Miscellaneous Equipment and Furnishings Capital Reserve Fund”, and it is the purpose of said capital reserve fund to fund the acquisition and purchase of such equipment by the Fire District;

**NOW BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, the Brockport Fire District is hereby authorized to expend from the “Brockport Fire District Miscellaneous Equipment and Furnishings Capital Reserve Fund” an amount not to exceed \$15,000 for the Hydra-Ram II, Forcible Entrytool.

**BE IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this resolution is subject to a permissive referendum and shall not take effect until 30 days has elapsed after its adoption, or unless approved at a special election of the qualified voters of the Brockport Fire District after a proper petition calling for such special election is filed with the secretary of the Brockport Fire District within the time permitted by law.

**Purchase of a Jumbo Siamese 4-inch Hose Adapter**

The following resolution was adopted by the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Brockport Fire District on August 17, 2026:

Resolution to expend from the “Brockport Fire District Miscellaneous Equipment and Furnishings Capital Reserve Fund” for the purchase of a Jumbo Siamese 4-inch Hose Adapter.

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to §6-g of the General Municipal Law, the Brockport Fire District, Towns of Sweden and Clarkson, County of Monroe, State of New York, did establish the “Brockport Miscellaneous Equipment and Furnishings Capital Reserve Fund”, a capital reserve fund to finance the cost of acquisition or replacement of miscellaneous equipment and furnishings utilized in the operation of the Brockport Fire District, including, but not limited to, furnishings and furniture for the fire stations, miscellaneous incidental equipment required to maintain the fire district’s facilities and other non-firefighting equipment and furnishings that are included in the definition of capital as set forth in General Municipal Law §6-g but not within the purposes of the other Brockport Fire District §6-g Capital Reserve Funds.

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to purchase the Jumbo Siamese 4- inch Hose Adapter. This valuable piece of equipment is a water-delivery tool used to combine two large-diameter hose lines into one single large line (or vice versa). It features quick-connect genderless Storz fittings and internal clapper valves that allow firefighters to add a secondary water line safely without interrupting the active water flow.

**WHEREAS**, the purchase of the Jumbo Siamese 4-inch Hose Adapter is to be financed from monies in the above-referenced “Brockport Fire District Miscellaneous Equipment and Furnishings Capital Reserve Fund”, and it is the purpose of said capital reserve fund to fund the acquisition and purchase of such equipment by the Fire District;

**NOW BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, the Brockport Fire District is hereby authorized to expend from the “Brockport Fire District Miscellaneous Equipment and Furnishings Capital Reserve Fund” an amount not to exceed \$6,000.00 for the Jumbo Siamese 4-inch Hose Adapter.

**BE IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this resolution is subject to a permissive referendum and shall not take effect until 30 days has elapsed after its adoption, or unless approved at a special election of the qualified voters of the Brockport Fire District after a proper petition calling for such special election is filed with the secretary of the Brockport Fire District within the time permitted by law.

**Purchase of 1000 feet : 4"x100' Jafrib Yellow Hose**

The following resolution was adopted by the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Brockport Fire District on August 17, 2026:

Resolution to expend from the "Brockport Fire District Miscellaneous Equipment and Furnishings Capital Reserve Fund" for the purchase of 1000 feet of 4' X 100' Jafrib Yellow Hose.

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to §6-g of the General Municipal Law, the Brockport Fire District, Towns of Sweden and Clarkson, County of Monroe, State of New York, did establish the "Brockport Miscellaneous Equipment and Furnishings Capital Reserve Fund", a capital reserve fund to finance the cost of acquisition or replacement of miscellaneous equipment and furnishings utilized in the operation of the Brockport Fire District, including, but not limited to, furnishings and furniture for the fire stations, miscellaneous incidental equipment required to maintain the fire district's facilities and other non-firefighting equipment and furnishings that are included in the definition of capital as set forth in General Municipal Law §6-g but not within the purposes of the other Brockport Fire District §6-g Capital Reserve Funds.

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to purchase the 1000 feet of 4" x 100' Jafrib Yellow Hose. This hose will replace Brockport Fire Districts worn and damage 4" Jafrib Yellow Hose. This hose is a heavy-duty, large-diameter supply and relay fire hose manufactured by Armtex/Kuriyama. It is used to move high volumes of water from fire hydrants or open sources to fire pumpers on fire trucks. This hose is an essential and necessary tool allowing our volunteers to perform their duties safely and efftely.

**WHEREAS**, the purchase of the 1000 feet of 4" x 100' Jafrib Yellow Hose is to be financed from monies in the above-referenced "Brockport Fire District Miscellaneous Equipment and Furnishings Capital Reserve Fund", and it is the purpose of said capital reserve fund to fund the acquisition and purchase of such equipment by the Fire District;

**NOW BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, the Brockport Fire District is hereby authorized to expend from the "Brockport Fire District Miscellaneous Equipment and Furnishings Capital Reserve Fund" an amount not to exceed \$10,000 for the 1000 feet of 4" x 100' Jafrib Yellow Hose.

**BE IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this resolution is subject to a permissive referendum and shall not take effect until 30 days has elapsed after its adoption, or unless approved at a special election of the qualified voters of the Brockport Fire District after a proper petition calling for such special election is filed with the secretary of the Brockport Fire District within the time permitted by law.

**Purchase of Bailout Window & 5 ft Heavy Duty Floating Floor**

The following resolution was adopted by the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Brockport Fire District on August 17, 2026:

Resolution to expend from the “Brockport Fire District Miscellaneous Equipment and Furnishings Capital Reserve Fund” for the purchase of a Bailout Window & 5 ft Heavy Duty Floating Floor.

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to §6-g of the General Municipal Law, the Brockport Fire District, Towns of Sweden and Clarkson, County of Monroe, State of New York, did establish the “Brockport Miscellaneous Equipment and Furnishings Capital Reserve Fund”, a capital reserve fund to finance the cost of acquisition or replacement of miscellaneous equipment and furnishings utilized in the operation of the Brockport Fire District, including, but not limited to, furnishings and furniture for the fire stations, miscellaneous incidental equipment required to maintain the fire district’s facilities and other non-firefighting equipment and furnishings that are included in the definition of capital as set forth in General Municipal Law §6-g but not within the purposes of the other Brockport Fire District §6-g Capital Reserve Funds.

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to purchase the Bailout Window & 5 ft Heavy Duty Floating Floor. This is an extremely useful tool for our firefighters. This provides a last resort exit route for firefighters trapped on upper floors by extreme fire or heat. This bailout window features minimal latching and wide openings to allow a person wearing heavy tactical or firefighting gear to dive out quickly. This item is needed to reduce the risk of injury when exiting during extreme calls.

**WHEREAS**, the purchase of the Bailout Window & 5 ft Heavy Duty Floating is to be financed from monies in the above-referenced “Brockport Fire District Miscellaneous Equipment and Furnishings Capital Reserve Fund”, and it is the purpose of said capital reserve fund to fund the acquisition and purchase of such equipment by the Fire District;

**NOW BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, the Brockport Fire District is hereby authorized to expend from the “Brockport Fire District Miscellaneous Equipment and Furnishings Capital Reserve Fund” an amount not to exceed \$15,000 for the Bailout Window & 5 ft Heavy Duty Floating Floor.

**BE IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this resolution is subject to a permissive referendum and shall not take effect until 30 days has elapsed after its adoption, or unless approved at a special election of the qualified voters of the Brockport Fire District after a proper petition calling for such special election is filed with the secretary of the Brockport Fire District within the time permitted by law.
